The Nuclear Energy Agency in Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD/NEA), in co-operation with Studsvik Nuclear AB, the Swedish Radiation Safety Authority (SSM), Swedish Nuclear Fuel and Waste Management Co (SKB) and AB SVAFO, is arranging a workshop on Radiological characterisation for decommissioning and dismantling

Objectives

The objective of the workshop is to share current practice, lessons learnt and innovations within radiological characterisation for decommissioning of nuclear sites and facilities. The outcome of the workshop will be captured in workshop proceedings and in the final NEA WPDD project report in early 2013.

The workshop aims to bring together operators, regulators, scientists, consultants and contractors to exchange information and views.

Students from colleges and universities will be invited and may participate subject to space being available.

- Session 3 Characterisation of land and groundwater
- Session 4 Software support, record keeping, quality assurance and logistics
